# Union Grove Christian School Dress Guidelines

## ***General Guidelines for K5-12***

- Clothing that is unclean, torn, too tight, or so loose as to appear sloppy is unacceptable.
- Beginning in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade clothing may not have large slogans, advertising, or writing on it. University sweatshirts or team/athletic attire would fit into this category. Small brand names or trademarks may be permissible. UGCS reserves the right to determine any emblem or trademark as unacceptable.
- Zipperless hooded sweatshirts and blankets are not to be worn or brought to school. (grades 7-12)
- The school frowns upon extreme fads of any nature. The administration reserves the right to initiate policies on new fads and changes in style throughout the school year.

## ***Girls - K5-6***

- Girls in the lower elementary grades (K5-3<sup>rd</sup> grade) may wear solid colored, full-length pants that are appropriately sized and modestly styled. **No denim** is allowed. Beginning in the 4<sup>th</sup> grade girls must wear skirts to class.
- Dresses or skirts with hemlines should come to the top of the knee when sitting or standing. Slits in skirts may not extend above the kneecap.
- Beginning in 4<sup>th</sup> grade sundresses and sleeveless tops may not be worn.
- Tank Tops, spaghetti-strapped and tight-fitting tops or outfits are not permissible. Necklines should always be modest in appearance.
- Shoes are always to be worn. No flip-flops are to be worn.
- The school frowns upon extreme fads of any nature.
- No more than 2 earrings are allowed in each ear. No other body piercings or tattoos are acceptable.

## ***Boys - K5-6***

- Pants must be neat, clean and in good repair. Nylon jogging suits, jogging shorts, sweat pants, baseball pants, or sleeveless T-Shirts should not be worn to school.
- Boys in K5-2 may wear shirts without collars, provided they are more than just undershirts.
- Beginning in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, shirts should have collars and they are to be tucked in at all times. Shirts must not have slogans, writing or advertisements written across them. Small trademarks are acceptable over the pocket area of the shirt.
- Hair must be neatly trimmed and tapered on the sides and back. Hair must be combed off the forehead in such a manner that it is not touching the eyebrows and cannot be artificially colored or bleached.
- Bracelets, necklaces, neck chains and earrings are not to be worn by any male student on campus or at any school related function.
- Tattoos and body piercings are unacceptable for male students.

## ***Girls - 7-12***

- Dresses or skirts with hemlines should come to the top of the knee when sitting or standing. Slits in skirts may not extend above the kneecap. Necklines should always be modest in appearance.
- Tank Tops, sleeveless tops and tight-fitting tops or outfits are not permissible.
- Shoes are always to be worn. No flip-flops are to be worn.
- No more than 2 earrings are allowed in each ear. No other body piercings or tattoos are acceptable.
- Female students may wear solid colored pants or Capri's that are modest and appropriately sized to athletic events. **No denim** will be allowed.

## ***Boys - 7-12***

- Pants that are neat, clean and in good repair are to be worn to school. Baggy pants are not permissible and belts must be worn on all pants.
- All shirts are to have collars and are to be tucked into pants.
- Sweaters must have a collared shirt or turtleneck underneath to be worn to school. Collars should be visible above the necklines
- Hair should be neat and trimmed at all times. Hair must be cut above the ears, not hanging on the collar. Sideburns are not to come lower than the top of the ear lobe. Male students must be clean shaven for all school activities and functions.
- Bracelets, necklaces, neck chains, and earrings are not to be worn by any UGCS male student.
- Body piercings and tattoos are unacceptable for male students at UGCS.
- Hats of any type are not to be worn in the building.

## ***Chapel Attire - 7-12***

- Although chapel may meet more than once a week, one chapel day, each week will be designated as a chapel attire day. The following is chapel attire. *Boys:* Dress or Casual pants (no denim), Dress shoes (no tennis shoes), Collared shirt. *Girls:* Dress or a Skirt (no denim), Collared shirt (can be polo styled), shoes (no tennis shoes).
